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Today we take our Scripture text from Psalm 85:6, "Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?"

Concerning America, the next two years will be very tumultuous. Sadly, America continues to travel down a road that will ultimately lead to its demise and destruction. Never before has a nation since Israel been so supernaturally blessed and yet become so rebellious. In the coming days, America will hemorrhage profusely! The coming days will produce damaging losses with people and valuable resources being ruined, lost, and destroyed because of sin.

I am more determined than ever to admonish everyone to pray and seek the face of God.

In spite of the coming judgments and severe losses America will suffer, Jehovah will also bring revival and spiritual renewal. America, along with the modern-day church, cannot be healed as long as we remain in our cesspool of sin. We must take off the gloves and proclaim the Word of God without compromise.

I'm convinced the majority of preachers today are not even God-called because there is no fervor emanating from within them authenticating the genuine power of the Holy Ghost. Any so called preacher without the anointing of the Holy Ghost is nothing more than a charlatan; openly portrayed as a mere circus leader and carnival barker.

You may think I am hard and harsh but, personally, I am tired of the petty, pathetic, trivial, limpwristed, preaching we encounter today. No wonder adultery and sod-

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omy have now filled the pulpits of America. Someone needs to plow deeply within the uncultivated souls of America until the fallow grounds are broken.

Obviously, I am not in a popularity contest vying for "votes" or "likes". You may feel I have lost hope but nothing could be further from the truth. Because of Almighty God, I know Jehovah can and will bring revival. The church will never be without hope because the Holy Ghost of God will always be in the midst of His church. The prophet Zechariah says, "For I, saith the LORD, will be unto her a wall (wall of protection) of fire round about, and will be the glory in the midst of her" (Zechariah 2:5). The true church, the body of Christ, is about to be surrounded by a wall of fire. God, through the Holy Ghost, is presently surrounding His church and empowering the true church with Holy Ghost power.

Several months ago I openly declared the next 24 to 26 months will be very tenuous for America. The shaking of the Lord around the globe has already begun; however few are able to discern what God is doing.

Sadly, we *Americanize* everything. The civil unrest we are presently witnessing in China is a sign the underground church is springing forth because they have been faithful and their prayers are being answered. We must remember, Jehovah is the God of all the earth. However, that does not negate China's desire to seize Taiwan.

The reelection of Benjamin Netanyahu is just another divine sign of more upheaval to come because, I

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believe, Israel will unilaterally attack Iran. Prime Minister Netanyahu believes he is back in office to deal with the existential threat from Iran.

Present Biden issued an executive order last year to create a digital currency by March 2023 that will run parallel with the dollar. All of these events are bringing the entire world to a head-on collision course with Almighty God.

I know some who read this newsletter may be overwhelmed concerning the many things presently happening. However, "lift up your heads" as the Word of God admonishes us to do concerning the last days: "And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh" (Luke 21:28).

Since the spring of 1979, I have prayed God would make me a soul winner and now I am praying He will allow me to touch the world in some small way. I pray that statement does not sound pompous or arrogant: however I have asked the Lord if my heart is vain and presumptuous to please forgive me because the laborers are few.

It is time for the church to gird its loins and walk in the power of the Holy Ghost. This is not an hour to be filled with fear and trepidation: instead we must be spirit-filled and led by the Holy Ghost. This is not a time for cowardice or timidity. The apostle Paul declared, "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind" (2 Timothy. 1:7). As blood-bought children of God, we cannot allow fear to dictate our lives. All of the great patriarchs in the

Holy Scriptures were subject to like passions just as we are: "Elias was a *man* (meaning he was a typical man) subject to like passions (typical feelings) as we are, and he prayed earnestly (supplicated) that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit" (James 5:17-18). There is much to be discerned from this passage of Scripture. Prayer is never a waste of time; prayer always yields wonderful results. God responds powerfully when we display our faith by sharing our hearts with Him.

Elijah asked God to withhold the rain and so it was. He prayed again and the heaven brought forth rain. What I find so beautiful in this passage is that after Elijah prayed, the earth brought forth her fruit.

If we remain diligent, then our prayers will also bring forth much fruit. The more I pray, the more I sense the need to pray. It is my heart's desire that everyone reading this newsletter begin to develop a greater prayer life because the coming days will demand it.

I know there are a lot of negative voices in the world and, sadly, those voices are impeding the faith, trust, and prayers of many saints.

Most everyone knows I preach adamantly against sin and back-sliding, however, I am certain when we diligently seek the face of God He will surely bring revival. I'm not speaking of making things better in the natural through prosperity or opulence – so we might become more apathetic and complacent – but rather bringing us into His most perfected plan, will, and purpose.

If the church will return to Christ with clean hands and pure hearts, this great turning will ultimately usher in the Second Coming of Christ!

Christ is not going to return without a dynamic move of the Holy Ghost. The seeds of revival are just now beginning to break the soil.

The world is about to witness a vast dichotomy, like two sets of train tracks. One track is leading to the glorious return of Christ. The other track is leading untold millions to a fiery hell and damnation.

World events will now accelerate and hasten the period known as the *Great Tribulation*. This is why the church must develop a more fervent prayer life because the modern church will soon suffer persecution far greater than ever before. If the latter glory is to be greater than the former, then the suffering must also be greater than the former.

What burdens my heart and grieves my spirit is that today's church is weak, anemic, and terribly shallow concerning the Word of God and Bible prophecy. Nearly 28 years ago, the Lord changed my perspective concerning Bible prophecy and the end times.

Most modern Christians today are just sitting around waiting for the rapture of the church. The fields are about to be ripened and made ready for the harvest and who will help in this gathering?

You were born for a time such as this, to be used of God to cultivate the fields for this End-Time Harvest. There's only one harvest according to **Matthew 13**, which makes it evident to all who have eyes to see and ears to hear there can only be one Second Coming of Christ.

Let me be very clear: the Great Tribulation has nothing to do with the Wrath of God. The Great Tribulation is simply the wrath of Satan: "Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time" (Revelation 12:12).

The Wrath of God is only found in the seven vial judgments: "And I heard a great voice out of the

temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials (or shallow cups) of the wrath of God upon the earth" (Revelation 16:1). This passage of Scripture makes it absolutely clear neither the seven seals nor the seven trumpets have anything to do with the Lamb's wrath.

Furthermore, the church has never been appointed to the Lamb's wrath because the blood of the Lamb delivers us from His wrath: "Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him (Jesus)" (Romans 5:9).

The apostle Paul exhorted: "For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation (to be rescued) by our Lord Jesus Christ. Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him" (1Thessalonians 5:9-10). Anyone washed in the blood of the Lamb will never suffer the wrath of the Lamb: to do so would be contrary to God's Word.
