We continue our newsletter series with our Scripture focus text: "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour..." (1 Peter 5:8). As you read this month's newsletter, Donald J. Trump is the 47<sup>th</sup> president of these United States. When you aggregate the numbers, 4+7 equals 11. In biblical numerology, the number 11 falls between 10 and 12. The number 10 means law and responsibility, thus making Israel responsible to keep the Decalogue. The number 12 speaks of divine government such as the 12 tribes of Israel, the 12 apostles, the 12 gates on New Jerusalem, along with its 12 foundations. Because the number 11 is between 10 and 12 it ultimately speaks of judgment and disorder.

I do not mean to sound pessimistic; however, the next four years will be very tempestuous. Personally, I am not looking for a Golden Age because that speaks of mythology and a time of immeasurable prosperity, placidity, tranquility, science, art, and philosophy. The Bible teaches us that the last days will be perilous, fierce, and furious. The apostle Paul cried aloud, *"This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come"* (2 Timothy 3:1).

The last days are a divinely appointed time when foreordained events must come to fruition because they are prophesied. The word "**times**" in Greek is <u>Kairos</u> (#2540 in The New Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible), which, in essence, means: Not a succession of time but a divine time when foreor-

dained events must take place and they must be fulfilled.

I believe President Donald Trump will be used by God to bring judgment upon America, which will ultimately produce disorder. Disorder is the disruption of peaceful and lawabiding behavior. Behavioral changes are about to erupt and impede this nation. Trump is already purging some of the alphabet agencies that have become lawless and corrupt.

Be assured, Satan will raise his ugly head to oppose this purge. This is why being *sober and vigilant* is of such importance. At this time, many ministries are struggling and collapsing because sin has flourished within their camps. Christendom, for the most part, is illiterate concerning the Word of God and, therefore, many don't understand what's taking place.

You may remember the spiritual purge in the 1980s, when two of the most visible ministries in America were all but destroyed through sin and scandal. Presently, the same things are happening again. Only a cynic would believe America can escape her divine appoint-

ment with judgment. If we do not stay sober and vigilant, we too will be swept away by the tide of iniquity. Perversity, wickedness, evil, slander, and debauchery are sweeping across America. Sadly, many immature Christians will fall by the wayside when God begins to mete out judgment. Tragically, the church is not prepared for what is to come. Ask yourself: Who is crying aloud and wielding the sword of the Lord without compromise? The prophet Isaiah shouted, "Cry aloud, spare (withhold) not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and shew my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins" (Isaiah 58:1).

Few today are crying aloud against the sins flooding the church. I am old-school, old-fashioned, but the Word of God will never, never change in spite of man's frailty. We read: "Son of man, I have made thee a watchman (observer) unto the house of Israel: therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me. When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn (admonish) the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand. Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness (perversity), nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul" (Ezekiel 3:17-19).

My heart is to never compromise the Word of our Lord and, therefore, be liable for souls lost. Hell will be full of ministers whose hands are

covered with the blood of the souls of men. I once had an open vision when I witnessed ministers, and doctors who had aborted babies, in hell and they were trying to sling the blood off their hands like water but were unable. What horror for all eternity in attempting to remove the blood from off their unholy and wicked hands. We read *"It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God"* (Hebrews 10:31).

Paul reiterates the danger in living a life of contempt toward God: *"For our God is a consuming fire"* (Hebrews 12:29).

King David, also cried aloud: "The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God" (Psalm 9:17).

The destiny of the wicked, and those who forget God, is eternal damnation and separation from God Almighty: "Now consider this, <u>ye</u> <u>that forget God</u>, lest I tear you in pieces, and there be none to deliver" (Psalm 50:22).

I am desperately attempting to help you be *sober and vigilant* concerning eternity and what awaits those who reject the King of Glory! Christ gave a very powerful instruction: *"But I will forewarn* (admonish) you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him" (Luke 12:5).

The word "hell" here does not speak of the grave but, rather, it is the Greek word *geenna* (#1067), which speaks of everlasting punishment: hell. I know very few dare speak of this place of torment because it is so horrifying! There are far too many charlatans in pulpits today that are cowardly, limpwristed, and effeminate. The only way things will change is to proclaim the Word of God without compromise.

America needs Holy Ghost, spirit-filled watchmen whose hearts burn with the fire of Jehovah, who will stand and cry aloud! No doubt they are few in number, but Elohim will not be left without a voice.

I am determined, by the grace of God, to remain faithful at my post. Apostasy has become rampant and spineless heretics are harming the church. When anyone departs from the Word of God they also depart from the Lamb of God.

In the coming days, trials and tribulations will grow exponentially. I adjure you, by the living God, to come to Christ because He is the embodiment of righteousness.

The modern church looks more like Hollywood and Nashville than the Lord's Christ. Multitudes are deceived and led astray by false doctrine and teachings. Only when true men of God return to proclaiming the immutable Word of God will righteousness prevail in America.

King Belshazzar, who was Nebuchadnezzar's grandson, in his reckless, drunken stupor, called for and abused the sacred vessels of God. I will never forget the revelation the Holy Spirit afforded me concerning the writing on the wall. The Chaldeans could not understand the writing on the wall because it was written in Hebrew and when Daniel walked in he knew immediately what God had said. How many people today can read the writing of God upon the wall? We read: "TEKEL; Thou art weighed in the balances, and art found wanting (deficient)" (Daniel 5:27). If suddenly you found yourself upon the scales of God, would

you be found wanting?

It is my humble plea that this simple newsletter has permeated and pierced your heart with deep Holy Ghost conviction! The only way to remain in fellowship with Christ is to abide in Him.
